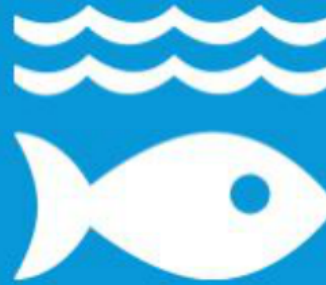

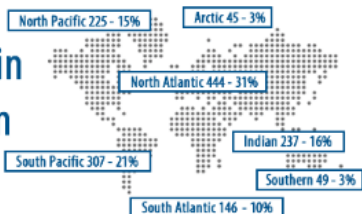

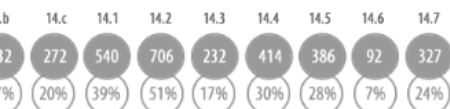
Ocean Basin Breakdown
