A medical certificate necessary for your flying licence?





Are you a class 1, 2, 4 or LAPL pilot? In that case, you must be **examined** by an approved medical practitioner in order to obtain or renew your flying licence. When flying, you must be holder of a valid **medical certificate**.

Are you looking for an expertise centre for your medical examination?

The **doctors** of the **Federal Aviation Medical** (FAM) of the Administration of Medical Expertise (Medex) are **accredited** by the FPS Mobility. The FAM delivers **certificates that meet the strict criteria** of the European Aviation Safety Agency (EASA).

All examinations (blood test, NET examination, eye examination, audiogram, spirometry, ECG...) are carried out **in the centre**, and last a couple of hours. It is therefore not necessary to visit various specialists. Certified specialists as well as material are available at the FAM.
